

## Remarks

- Please provide 4 separate monitor groups for the full band setup. Each with one or two suitable wedges.
- At least one (1) tap delay and one (1) or more Multi-effects. Please have them patched and ready.
- Vocal 1 is a Shure SM58, no replacements.
- The band always brings own full set of backline, sharing is not appreciated.
- Usually the certain animals play in a compact stage setting. On a wide stage a lot of side space is unused.
- If possible the band would like to place a banner behind the drums. Size: 3x2m.
- The drummer prefers to play without a drum riser. However in a big venue or in a venue with a high stage (>1m) a riser might be requested.

Full-band setup

Five (5) persons. Four(4) band members and one (1) sound engineer. Please provide parking for Three (3) vehicles: one small van and two cars.

The band will contact the venue if any exceptions or changes will be made for a show.

Please provide a dressing room, that can be locked, for the band to change and refresh.

Please provide the following in the dressing room:

- Clean towels
- Fitting mirror
- Water
- Tea (ginger and honey would be nice)
- Coffee
- Beer (normal & alcohol free)
- Soft drinks

If the get in time is before 19:00 hours: please provide a healthy and nutritious meal.
